Dorothy Day and The Catholic Workers Movement

In 2019 the Women of St Joseph had a presentation from Casa de Clara in San Jose, an independent arm of The Catholic Workers Movement founded by Dorothy Day. For me, the most valuable aspect of that meeting was learning how Casa de Clara was living out Dorothy Day's legacy as a community committed to a shared life of prayer and action in

joyful service to people on the margins of life. They offer transitional housing for women with children and single women. They even raised enough money to purchase a portable shower called "Shower to the People". What a great treat for the homeless to get a shower, clean pair of socks and t-shirt along with their nails and even hair cut!

I receive their quarterly newsletters and was surprised to get one recently from Fumi, the former coordinator of that house, and Jessica also a team member. They are starting a NEW Catholic Worker house in Portland Oregon named Dandelion House. Why dandelion? "It is tenacious and resilient, thriving in city sidewalks and lawns. Fumi likes dandelions for the beauty and joy they bring him in the springtime and hope the house will be infused with some of that spirit."

He asks for help to get the project off the ground. They already have received a generous donation of \$400,000 and need \$300,000 more to purchase a home.
