Our Operating Income – Our operating income comes entirely from our parishioners and supports the day-to-day operation of the church.

Total operating income of \$461,953 is 61% lower than our budget and 45% lower than the same time last year. Plate collection of \$433,028 is 39% lower than budget and 39% lower than the same time last year. This is mainly due to a few families who moved out of Fremont and used to donate an average of 10% of our plate collection. We did not receive a large bequest this year compared to the same time last year.

Our Operating Expenses - We are primarily a service organization and thus, most of our expenses relate to staffing and facilities.

Total operating expense of \$649,226 is tracking to budget but is 11% higher than the same time last year. Our Diocesan assessment is 79% higher based upon our 2021 financial statement. We received generous donations for our different beautification projects in 2021, and they were assessed by the Diocese this

year. Early expenses include trimming of more than fifty palm trees, rectory termite fumigation, and grounds clean up along the creek.
