





Lent Begins: Ash Wednesday is this Wednesday

Lent is a 40 day season of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. Please join us this February 14 as we begin the season of Lent. The blessing and imposition of ashes will take place at all Masses. 8:00 AM in the Mission & all other Masses are in the main church. 9:15 (SJ School), Noon, 5:00 (Vietnamese), 7:00 (English/Mandarin). Ash Wednesday is a day of fast and abstinence. The norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18-59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. Abstinence from meat is binding upon members from age 14 onwards. Fast & Abstinence are part of the selfdiscipline practices in preparation for receiving our Resurrected Lord at Easter.
