Jesus, a real historical figure, walked among us, was arrested, suffered, and died on the cross. Eyewitnesses confirmed His death and burial (John 19:33-35). Yet, the story does not end there. The same Jesus rose from the dead, appearing to His disciples at different times and places (Luke 24:36-43; John 20:19-29). It means that life with God is our true destiny. Jesus promised, "I am the resurrection and the life. The one who believes in me will live, even though they die" (John 11:25). Our earthly journey is a path toward heaven, where we are called to live forever in His presence. The resurrection assures us that death has been conquered (1 Corinthians 15:54-55), and through Christ, we are invited to share in eternal life.

As we rejoice this Easter, let us renew our commitment to walk with Christ, trusting in His promise and striving for our ultimate goal—to be with God in heaven. May the joy of the Risen Lord fill your hearts and homes today and always. *Happy Easter!*
