

### DEAR ALL IN CHRIST,

On this Divine Mercy Sunday, April 27, 2025, we gather as a faith community to reflect on the boundless mercy of God and our sacred calling to embody that mercy in our lives. This special day, instituted by St. John Paul II in 2000, invites us to immerse ourselves in the profound truth of God's merciful love and to respond with concrete acts of compassion that mirror His divine heart.

#### God's Merciful Love: A Sacrifice for Our Salvation

At the core of Divine Mercy Sunday is the awe-inspiring reality of God's mercy. Scripture reminds us, "God so loved the world that He gave His only Son, so that everyone who believes in Him might not perish but have eternal life" (John 3:16). When humanity turned away through sin, God did not respond with vengeance or condemnation. Instead, in an act of unfathomable love, He embraced the cross, bearing the weight of our transgressions. Jesus' death and resurrection are the ultimate proof of God's merciful love-a love that forgives, redeems, and opens the way to eternal salvation. As St. Faustina Kowalska, the apostle of Divine Mercy, recorded in her diary, "Mankind will not have peace until it turns with trust to My mercy." This Sunday, we are called to trust in that mercy, to seek forgiveness, and to rest in the assurance that God's love is greater than our failings.

#### Our Call to Be Merciful: Faith in Action

Divine Mercy Sunday is not only a celebration of God's mercy but also a challenge to live as merciful disciples. Jesus taught, "Be merciful, just as your Father is merciful" (Luke 6:36). Words of faith, no matter how eloquent, are insufficient if they are not accompanied by actions that reflect God's love. As a parish, we are blessed to answer this call through tangible works of mercy that serve as visible signs of our commitment to Christ.

Our community has embraced the mission of mercy with open hearts. We welcome refugee families, helping them resettle and rebuild their lives in a new land. Each week, we feed the poor and homeless, offering not just nourishment but dignity and hope. We extend support to other churches, strengthening their ministries and fostering unity in Christ's name. When families face desperate situations, we step in to help pay bills, easing their burdens. Collectively, our parish invests over \$100,000 annually in these acts of mercy, a testament to our shared faith and love for God. These efforts are not mere charity; they are the embodiment of our discipleship, a response to Jesus' command to love our neighbor as ourselves.

#### A Blessed Calling This Divine Mercy Sunday

As we celebrate Divine Mercy Sunday, we are reminded that we are both recipients and channels of God's mercy. We are blessed to be forgiven, to be loved, and to be saved by a God who never gives up on us. In turn, we are called to extend that same mercy to others, not through words alone but through actions that transform lives. Our parish's ongoing works of mercy—supporting refugees, feeding the hungry, aiding struggling families, and partnering with other communities—reflect the heart of the Gospel and the spirit of Divine Mercy.

Let this Divine Mercy Sunday renew our commitment to trust in God's mercy and to live it out boldly. May we continue to be a beacon of hope and compassion, showing the world that God's merciful love is alive in us. As we pray the Divine Mercy Chaplet and reflect on Jesus' promise, "I am love and mercy itself," let us go forth as His disciples, making mercy the hallmark of our lives. "Blessed are the merciful, for they will be shown mercy" (Matthew 5:7).


