DEAR BROTHERS AND SISTERS IN CHRIST,

On June 11, 1797, Mission San José was founded in what is now Fremont, California, a moment imbued with profound theological, spiritual, and cultural significance. As we commemorate this historic event, we are drawn to the mystery of the Holy Trinity—Father, Son, and Holy Spirit—a divine truth that shapes our faith and the legacy of this mission.

The Holy Trinity, the heart of Christian belief, reveals God as three persons in one divine essence, united in perfect love and communion. As Jesus declares in John 10:30, “I and the Father are one,” and in Matthew 28:19, He commissions us to “baptize in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.” This sacred mystery invites us to live in unity and love, reflecting the relational nature of God. The Trinity calls us to emulate this divine communion, as St. Paul urges in 2 Corinthians 13:14: “May the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you all.” Mission San José was founded to embody this call, fostering a community where faith and love unite diverse peoples in the image of the Triune God.

Established by Spanish Franciscan missionaries under the leadership of St. Junípero Serra, Mission San José became the fourteenth of California’s 21 missions, dedicated to spreading the Gospel among the Ohlone people and others. St. Junípero Serra, whose heart burned with missionary zeal, once said, “All my life I have wanted to be a missionary. I have wanted to carry the Gospel message to those who have never heard of God and the kingdom He has prepared for them.” His vision animated the founding of Mission San José on June 11, 1797, creating a spiritual home where faith could flourish. Serra’s words echo the Trinitarian mission to share God’s love, as seen in John 3:16: “For God so loved the world that He gave His one and only Son.” The mission’s simple yet sacred church stands as a testament to this love, inviting all to encounter the Trinity through worship and community.

Theologically, Mission San José reflects the Trinitarian

principle of unity in diversity. The missionaries, inspired by Serra’s call to “always go forward and never turn back,” built a community where the love of God was shared through sacraments and service. Spiritually, the mission offered a space for encountering God, as Psalm 133:1 reminds us: “How good and pleasant it is when God’s people live together in unity!” Culturally, Mission San José became a vibrant crossroads, blending Spanish, indigenous, and later Mexican traditions into a rich heritage of faith, music, and art. This cultural harmony mirrors the Trinity’s unity, embracing all peoples under God’s grace.

We offer heartfelt thanks to all who have sustained Mission San José, past and present. To St. Junípero Serra and the early missionaries, your courage laid a foundation of faith. To the indigenous peoples who shaped its early life, your presence enriched its legacy. To the priests, religious, and laypeople who have carried its mission through centuries, your dedication reflects the Trinity’s enduring love. To today’s parishioners, volunteers, and supporters—those who maintain the mission’s grounds, lead liturgies, or offer prayers and resources—your service makes this place a living reflection of God’s communion. As St. Junípero Serra said, “The only thing that matters is to save souls.” Your efforts continue this sacred work, bringing souls closer to God.

Let us pray: Loving God, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, we thank You for the mystery of Your Triune love, revealed in John 17:21, that all may be one as You are one. Bless all who have built Mission San José since 1797. May their work, inspired by St. Junípero Serra’s zeal, bear fruit in hearts drawn to You. Guide us to reflect Your unity and love, and may Mission San José remain a beacon of faith for generations. Amen.
