THE MISSION OF THE SEVENTY-TWO DISCIPLES

DEAR ALL IN CHRIST,

The mission of the seventy-two disciples, as described in Luke 10:1-20, offers profound guidance for those called to serve in ministry.

First, we must recognize that serving the Lord and His community is a sacred privilege and gift. As Jesus instructs, “The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few” (Luke 10:2), reminding ministers to align their hearts with God’s will, setting aside personal ego and agendas to faithfully carry out His divine purpose. The Catechism of the Catholic Church (CCC 767) affirms this, stating that the Church, empowered by the Holy Spirit, continues Christ’s mission through its disciples, called to serve humbly.

Second, the disciples were sent out in pairs (Luke 10:1), a reminder that God’s work is not a solitary endeavor. We are called to collaborate, stay connected, and remain united with others, reflecting the unity of the Body of Christ (1 Corinthians 12:12-27). The Catechism emphasizes this communal aspect of discipleship, noting that “the faithful are called to exercise their mission in the Church and in the world” through mutual support (CCC 910). No one should boast in their own strengths, but rely on collective efforts to fulfill God’s plan.

Third, Jesus instructed the seventy-two to trust in His divine providence, saying, “Carry no money bag, no sack, no sandals” (Luke 10:4). Their role was to focus on doing what is right and holy, depending entirely on God for their needs. This trust is rooted in faith, as Jesus assures, “Whoever believes in me will do the works that I do” (John 14:12). The Catechism reinforces this, teaching that disciples must rely on God’s grace to fulfill their mission (CCC 1533).

Finally, the ultimate goal of their mission—and ours—is to live in the abundant life God promises to those who love Him, as Jesus declares, “I came that they may have life and have it abundantly” (John 10:10). The Catechism underscores this eternal perspective, stating that discipleship leads to communion with God and participation in His divine life (CCC 1997).

Let us embrace this calling with humility, unity, trust, and a heart fixed on the eternal life God has prepared for us.

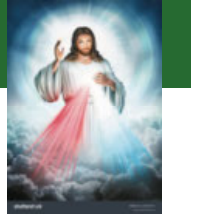

Homeless Outreach Ministry—An Urgent Call to Serve the Unhoused

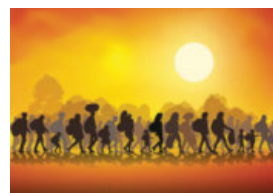
