Living the Mission with
Christ:
Hope Does Not Disappoint



DEAR FRIENDS IN CHRIST,

Each day, we are given a choice to believe either that God is in control of everything and that good things are in store, or we can go around worried and terrified. What do you fear? Many of us have fears about all kinds of things: dying, rejection, commitment in relationships, financial collapse, failure, body image—so many daily fears. How do we free ourselves from fear? How do we let go of societal expectations?

In the Gospel, we hear Jesus tell his disciples: “Do not be afraid any longer, little flock, for your Father is pleased to give you the kingdom.” And in the second reading, St. Paul says faith is the realization of what is hoped for and evidence of things not seen. By faith, Abraham obeyed and went out to a place he knew nothing about. By faith, he received the power to procreate, even though he was past the normal age.

Fear and faith have something in common. They both ask us to believe in something that is going to happen, even though we cannot know for sure. Fear says this business is slow, and you are going to go under. Faith says God supplies all of my needs. Fear says you have been through so much, and you are not going to be happy again. Faith says my best days are still ahead of me. Here is the key: whatever you meditate on is going to take root. If you dwell on fear again and again, you give it the right to become reality. Just as faith can bring about good things, fear can bring about bad things. When you go around expecting the worst, it's like inviting it into your life.

So friends, when fear knocks, let faith answer the door. I remember once I was flying from Boston to California early in the morning, and our flight was delayed for hours because of the fog. Everywhere we looked, we could barely see anything around; I thought the whole city was covered by fog. But when we took off, I looked down and noticed it was just a pocket of fog surrounding the airport. This is how fear is. Fear presents itself as much bigger than its reality. It tells you all the worst-case scenarios to try to make you worried, anxious, uptight, and panicked. If we give in to fear, we give Satan a chance to pass. We endanger our soul. When fear knocks, just smile and say, “Fear, I know your tricks. You are all bark and no bite. You may look big, but I am not impressed. You may be big, but our God is bigger. The obstacles you set up may be high, but we serve the Most High God.” That is how you activate faith and do not give in to fear.

By saying, “Don’t be afraid any longer, little flock, for your Father is pleased to give you the kingdom,” He is asking us to trust, to surrender to the providential mercy and direction of God. He is asking us to have faith.

May God take away our fear and increase our faith so that in all the storms of life, we shall have our eyes and our trust fixed on Him, and be faithful to Him. We ask this in Jesus’ name. Amen.

Parish Solar Project Under Construction

Work to install solar photovoltaic panels on the roofs of the kindergarten and parish storage buildings began July 22 and will be completed the first week of



August. These flat, unshaded roofs are ideal for solar panels, which will send electricity during the day to PG&E's electric

grid. This solar system—the final phase of our church renovation project—will help offset the cost of

operating the church's new electric-powered heating and air conditioning system. Because the system is parish-owned, we will receive 100% of the value of the electricity it generates.

Any excess energy will further reduce PG&E bills for the school and other parish buildings.

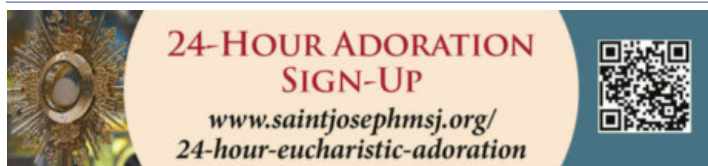

Reflections on Interactions with the Unhoused

Often, as I prepare for bed, my thoughts turn to those who sleep without shelter. I am protected by four walls and a roof, while the unhoused endure the elements with little to shield them. The disparity weighs heavily on me. I’d like to share two brief encounters. Mr. Herb earned a degree in Electrical Engineering from Cornell in 1979. He designed computers in Silicon Valley and traveled the world teaching others. Today, he lives in his car. Mr. Peter is often seen walking alone, pushing a cart with all his belongings. He rarely accepts food, preferring solitude to spend time with God. He sleeps at bus stops to avoid trouble with law enforcement.

These encounters led me to wonder: Where is God in all this? Then came a moment of clarity: I may not see God directly, but I experience Him—through all of you. Your prayers, generosity, and compassion make the Homeless Outreach Ministry possible. Through your witness, God is made present to the unhoused—and to me. For that, we thank you.

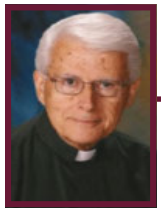
