Christ:

Hope Does Not Disappoint









DEAR BROTHERS AND SISTERS IN CHRIST,

A major theme of this Sunday's readings is humility. The first reading states, "My child, conduct your affairs with humility, and you will be loved more than a giver of gifts. The more you humble yourself, the greater you are, and you will find favor with God." In the Gospel, Jesus says, "when you are invited to a banquet, go and take the lowest place so that when the host comes to you he may say, 'My friend, move up to a higher position.' Then you will enjoy the esteem of your companions at the table. For everyone who exalts himself will be humbled, but the one who humbles himself will be exalted." Humility is truly the door to holiness and salvation.

Unfortunately, humility is not an attractive virtue in our modern world. The word itself comes from the Latin "humus," meaning "soil"—the very foundation we walk on. While everyone desires diamonds and gold, it's important to remember that these precious things originate from the soil. Just as soil is essential to our earthly existence, humility is essential to our soul. Though not always appealing, humility is necessary for our salvation and is the mother of many virtues, including obedience, reverence, patience, modesty, meekness, and peace.

St. Augustine once said that if asked the easiest ways to heaven, he would reply, "First is humility; the second is humility, and the third is humility." He is right. The gate to heaven is narrow, as we heard in last Sunday's Gospel. We cannot enter it without bowing down. A prevalent issue in our society today is the belief that people are the center of the universe and can accomplish anything on their own.

After the construction of the Titanic, a reporter asked the builder about the ship's safety, and he confidently replied, "Not even God can sink it." Yet, God didn't have to; an iceberg was enough. There's an old saying: "There are two most important things in life: First there is God; second, I am not he." This is the only way to live this life as it is meant to be. Therefore, be humble so you may be exalted.

However, we must be aware of false humility. Humility can be a hidden form of pride, such as an arrogant person claiming, "I am so proud that I am humble." Intentionally seeking the lowest place to be elevated to a higher one is also false humility. Being humble does not mean suppressing one's personal attributes; it doesn't involve a beautiful woman calling herself ugly or an intelligent man calling himself stupid. The humble person knows their place and takes it. If a humble person is meant to rule, they rule; and when they are meant to serve, they serve. Even in their most triumphant moments, the humble person remembers that all they are and all they have comes from God. They do not mistake God's gifts for their own sole achievement. This is what separates the humble from the proud.

So, what is humility? Humility says, "I know who I am in God's eyes—And that's enough." May God help us know ourselves as servants of God, learn to trust in Him, and praise Him forever and ever. Amen.

Refugee Family Settling In


Few families are currently arriving through IRC, and most must now finance their own journey.
