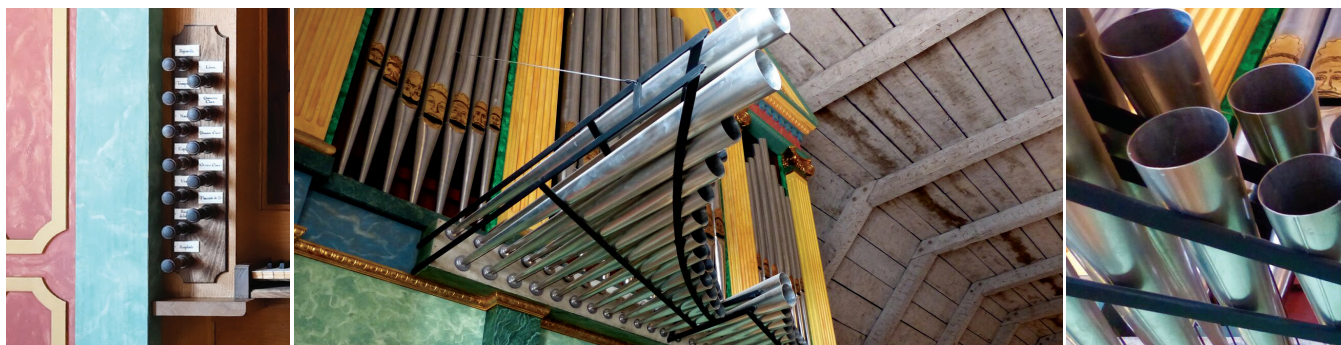

RONALD E. MCKEAN

Appointed in 2011, Mr. Ronald McKean has faithfully served as Campus-Wide Director of Music Ministries, Choirmaster, and Organist at St. Joseph Catholic Church/Mission San José.

Prior to his tenure here, he was Music Director and Organist at First Presbyterian Church in Oakland for twenty-five years. His academic training includes studies under the

legendary Thomas Binkley at Indiana University's Jacobs School of Music, where he earned a Master of Music degree in Harpsichord and a Performer's Certificate in seventeenth-century Italian and Spanish keyboard music. He also studied composition, organ, and theory under Kenneth Mansfield at California State University, Hayward—where he later served as Professor of Organ and Harpsichord. His exceptional gift for improvisation led to an appointment at Stanford University, where he taught with distinction.

Mr. McKean has performed and competed nationally and internationally, appearing on distinguished stages in Haarlem, the Netherlands, Boston, and San Anselmo. His acclaimed compositions—ranging from *Sacred Harp Diads for Violin and Harpsichord* to *Three Etudes for Organ*—have been premiered by students of The Juilliard School, at U.C. Berkeley's Hertz Hall, and at Stanford University's Memorial Chapel.

A distinguished educator and improviser, Mr. McKean continues to inspire generations of musicians with artistry, scholarship, and devotion to the Church's sacred music tradition.
