

HOLY SACRIFICE OF THE MASS

Twenty-Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time

September 28, 2025



DEAR BROTHERS AND SISTERS IN CHRIST.

The Gospel of this Sunday narrates the parable of the Rich Man and Lazarus. Upon reading, we may question why the rich man ended up in hell. The parable doesn't tell us that he gained his wealth unjustly. We are not informed of any crime or evil act he committed. So, why did he go to hell? He went to hell because of the sin of omission. This parable serves as a reminder that neglecting to do good can also lead to damnation.

If the rich man's downfall was due to omission, what granted Lazarus entry to heaven? The parable does not explicitly describe him as a devout man or credit him with good deeds. However, his name offers insight. In biblical context, names are significant, often reflecting a person's character. Lazarus means "God is my help," which earned earned him a place in Paradise. Today, many "Lazarus" figures still exist around us, and we are called to help them. As St. Teresa of Ávila reminds us: "Christ has no body now but yours. No hands, no feet on earth but yours. Yours are the eyes through which He looks with compassion on this world." By contributing funds, coupled with their efforts, we collectively address the needs of our brothers and sisters, leading us towards salvation.


