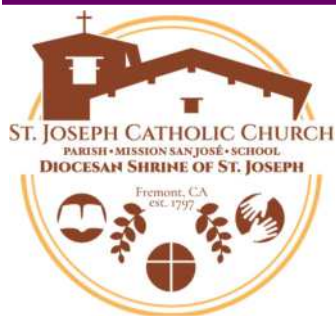

November 2, 2025



CELEBRATING ALL SAINTS AND COMMEMORATING ALL SOULS



We have just entered the month of November. If there is one month that feels especially meaningful and dear to us, it is this one.

Nature itself seems to join in the spirit of remembrance as the colors change and the air grows still. November is a time for Thanksgiving and for the Church to honor All Saints and All Souls. It is when the three parts of the Church — the Church Triumphant in heaven, the Church Suffering in purgatory, and we, the Church Militant on earth — come together in faith, remembrance, and love. That is the beauty of our faith: a communion that transcends time and space.

Yesterday we celebrated All Saints' Day, honoring the Church Triumphant — those who have completed the race, fought the good fight, and now rejoice in the heavenly banquet. Today, on All Souls' Day, we remember and pray for the Church Suffering — the souls in purgatory who are being purified and prepared to be fully united with God.

Some ask, "Is there really a purgatory?" The answer is yes — both reason and faith affirm it. Reason tells us there must be a state of purification for those who are neither wholly perfect for heaven nor wicked enough for hell. From the earliest days of Christianity, believers have prayed for the dead. While Scripture does not use the word *purgatory* explicitly, it is implied in the Second Book of Maccabees (chapter 12), where prayers are offered for the repose of the dead.

The Book of Wisdom (chapter 3) also speaks of souls undergoing a time of trial and purification, yet ultimately finding peace in the presence of God. As Revelation 21:27 reminds us, "Nothing unclean shall enter heaven."

That is why we light candles and offer Masses for our departed loved ones. In every celebration of the Eucharist, we pray for them. This is one of the most beautiful aspects of our Catholic faith — the communion of saints, the unbroken bond between the living and the dead. We pray for them, and they, in turn, intercede for us. Even when we are confident that our loved ones are in heaven, our prayers for them are not in vain; the blessings we offer return to us, helping us on our own journey toward eternal life.

Many among us are grieving — some have recently lost a loved one, while others still ache for someone gone long ago. The Feast of All Souls and the entire month of November offer deep consolation. If your heart carries pain, regret, or words left unsaid, entrust those feelings to God and ask the faithful departed to intercede for your healing and peace. The comforting truth of the Communion of Saints assures us that our bonds of love are never broken, even by death.

Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon them. May they rest in peace. Amen.
