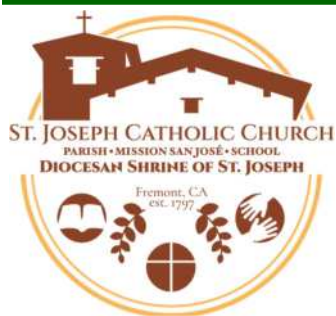

The readings today invite us to reflect on gratitude through two remarkable stories: the healing of Naaman in the first reading and the thankful Samaritan leper in the Gospel.

Since we know the Gospel story well, let us focus on Naaman and discover what his journey teaches us about faith, humility, and thanksgiving.

Naaman was a powerful army commander of the king of Syria—a man of great success and honor. Yet behind his strength was a painful weakness: he suffered from leprosy. In his household there was a young slave girl from Israel who told him about the prophet Elisha, who could heal him.

Naaman went to Israel, seeking help. When he arrived, Elisha did not even come out to meet him but sent word: “Go and wash seven times in the Jordan River, and you will be cleansed.”

Naaman felt insulted. “Are not the rivers of my homeland better than all the waters of Israel?” he protested. But finally, he humbled himself, followed the prophet’s command, and was healed. Filled with gratitude, he took some soil from Israel so that he could worship the true God on his own land.

This story holds three beautiful lessons for our spiritual life:

1. God uses our weaknesses to draw us closer to Him.

Naaman’s success did not bring him to God—his sickness did. So it often is with us. The very weakness or struggle we want to escape may be the path that leads us to healing and faith.

2. Humility opens the door to grace.

Naaman’s healing began when he listened to a humble servant girl and obeyed a prophet’s simple command. Pride resists God; humility welcomes Him. Healing and peace come when we let go of our pride and open our hearts.

3. The road to holiness is never easy.

Naaman faced doubts, obstacles, and misunderstanding. Yet he persevered. Likewise, we meet distractions, temptations, and excuses that try to keep us from prayer, Mass, or confession. But grace comes to those who keep seeking.

Let us learn from Naaman to trust God’s ways, even when they seem small or strange. And with grateful hearts, let us pray:

*“For all that has been, thanks.
For all that will be, yes.”*

Update! First Friday and First Saturday Devotions

Beginning with First Friday Mass on November 7, 2025, First Friday Mass will **always** be celebrated in the Main Church and will conclude with formal Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament. The devotion will continue with 24-hour Adoration in the Main Church, ending with formal Benediction immediately prior to the Saturday morning Mass.

When First Friday and First Saturday fall consecutively, both liturgies will be held in the Main Church. The Mission will remain closed until the Mission Museum opens.

Exceptions: When First Saturday occurs the weekend prior to First Friday (as in November 2025 and August 2026), those two First Saturday Masses will remain in the Mission. All other First Saturday morning Masses through 2026 will be held in the Main Church. Please mark your calendar.
