THE BEATITUDES: GOD'S UPSIDE-DOWN WAY TO HAPPINESS



Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ, In today's Gospel, Jesus proclaims the Beatitudes—eight short sentences that quietly turn our world upside down. At first glance, they sound almost unrealistic:

Blessed are the poor... the meek... those who mourn... the persecuted. In a culture that celebrates success, comfort, popularity, and power, Jesus dares to call something else "blessed."

The word *blessed* can also be translated as happy. But this is not the fleeting happiness that comes from money, comfort, or applause. Jesus speaks of a deeper joy—a happiness rooted in God, one that no suffering or circumstance can take away.

"Blessed are the poor in spirit." This does not mean praising poverty itself, but praising hearts that know their need for God. When we stop pretending that we are self-sufficient, we make room for God's grace. A poor spirit is a trusting spirit, like a child who knows everything is a gift.

"Blessed are those who mourn." Jesus does not deny pain or loss. Instead, He promises that God is closest to us in our tears. When we mourn—with compassion for others or sorrow for sin—our hearts are opened to God's healing and comfort.

"Blessed are the meek." Meekness is not weakness. It is strength under control. The meek choose humility over pride, patience over anger, forgiveness over revenge. In a loud world, meekness speaks quietly—but powerfully—of Christ.

"Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness." This is the longing to live rightly with God and others. It is the desire for justice, honesty, and holiness—not just in society, but in our own lives. God promises that such hunger will never go unanswered.

"Blessed are the merciful." Mercy is love in action. Every time we forgive, show compassion, or give someone a second chance, we reflect the very heart of God. As Jesus reminds us, the measure we use for others will be used for us.

"Blessed are the clean of heart." A pure heart sees God everywhere—in prayer, in Scripture, and in the faces of others. Purity of heart means having a single desire: to love God above all else.

"Blessed are the peacemakers." True peace is more than the absence of conflict. It is the presence of love, truth, and reconciliation. Peacemakers often work quietly, bridging divides in families, parishes, and communities.

Finally, "Blessed are those who are persecuted for righteousness." Faithfulness to Christ may bring misunderstanding or rejection. Yet Jesus assures us that when we stand with Him, we already belong to the Kingdom of Heaven.

The Beatitudes are not just ideals to admire—they are a way of life. They show us that true happiness is found not in having more, but in loving more. May we ask for the grace to live these words each day, trusting that God's way, though challenging, always leads to joy.

NOP—Neighborhood Outreach Project began

HOM First Year at St. Joseph—We successfully completed our first year as a new ministry, serving the unhoused in Fremont through the dedication of 40+ volunteers and the generous support of our parish community. From Dec 2024–Nov 2025, HOM delivered 4,877 grocery bags at a total cost of \$43,850—an average of 406 bags per month. We are

especially thankful for Sr. John Marie's Pantry (SJMP) for providing \$1,000/month in support during this first year. Beginning in 2026, HOM will operate with 28% less funding, as SJMP support ended Dec 2025.
