MOTHER'S DAY: LOVE MADE VISIBLE THROUGH SACRIFICE



Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

“If you love me, you will keep my commandments” (John 14:15). On this Mother’s Day, these words of Jesus take on a beautiful and concrete meaning. For if we want to

understand what love looks like in real life, we do not have to look very far—we can look to our mothers.

For Jesus, there is only one true test of love—sacrifice. Love must be lived and made visible in action. In a special way, mothers embody this truth every day. A mother’s love is rarely loud or dramatic, but it is constant, faithful, and sacrificial. It is love that gives, serves, and endures.

Think of a mother caring for her child through sleepless nights, putting aside her own rest. Think of the quiet sacrifices she makes—meals prepared, worries carried, prayers whispered, tears hidden. A mother may not always say, “I love you” in words, but her whole life speaks it. Her love is written in sacrifice.

We all know how easy it is to say “I love you.” Yet mothers teach us that love is much more than words. It is patience when children are difficult. It is forgiveness when they fail. It is hope when others give up. In this way, mothers reflect the very love of God—steadfast, merciful, and self-giving.

How did God show His love for us? He did not remain distant. He came close, entering into our human life, and gave Himself completely on the cross. In a similar way, mothers come close to their children—not only in moments of joy, but also in times of pain, confusion,

and struggle. Their love is not theoretical; it is lived, often at great personal cost.

On this day, we are invited not only to honor our mothers, but also to learn from them. Their example challenges us: Do we love with sacrifice? Do we put others before ourselves? Do we remain faithful even when love is difficult?

Perhaps the best gift we can offer our mothers is not just flowers or words, but a life that reflects what they have taught us. A phone call, a visit, a gesture of gratitude, a sincere “thank you”—these are simple ways to return love with love. And for those whose mothers have passed away, our prayers and remembrance become our offering of love.

Mother’s Day is also a moment to recognize all who share in this maternal love—grandmothers, godmothers, caregivers, and spiritual mothers—women who nurture, guide, and sacrifice for others.

Today, let us thank God for the gift of mothers. Through their sacrifices, we catch a glimpse of Christ’s own love. And inspired by their example, let us strive to live out His command: “If you love me, you will keep my commandments.”

Lord, bless all mothers, living and deceased. Reward their sacrifices with Your grace and peace. Help us to love as they have loved—with generosity, patience, and sacrifice.

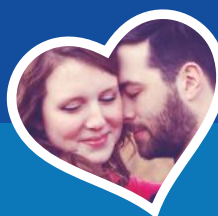
