HAPPY BIRTHDAY OF THE CHURCH



Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Pentecost is often called the birthday of the Church. The word “Pentecost” means fifty days. Fifty days after the Israelites passed through the Red Sea, God gave them the Ten

Commandments on Mount Sinai. In the same way, fifty days after Easter, God gave the Holy Spirit to the Church. Today we celebrate that great gift.

Do you know that the Catholic Church is the oldest human institution still in existence today? Through scandals, persecutions, wars, and divisions, the Church still stands. Why? The answer is simple: the Holy Spirit. There is a famous story about Napoleon Bonaparte. One day he told a cardinal, “Do you not know that I have the power to destroy the Catholic Church?” The cardinal calmly replied, “Your Majesty, we clergy have tried to destroy the Church for almost two thousand years, and we have not succeeded. Neither will you.” The Church survives not because of human genius, but because the hand of God sustains her. As Pope Benedict XVI once said, it is the Holy Spirit who keeps the Church alive.

Friends, life is full of mysteries. The Holy Spirit is at work everywhere. We see it in the beauty of creation: the galaxies, the oceans, the Grand Canyon, and even in the tiny acorn that grows into a mighty oak tree. We see it in the human body, where countless parts work together in harmony. God’s Spirit continues to hold the world together and breathe life into creation.

The Holy Spirit also inspires people. You can easily tell the difference between someone who is inspired and someone who is not. One is filled with joy, energy,

and hope; the other with negativity and gloom. You can even see it in sports. One team plays with passion and confidence, while the other looks defeated before the game is over. The disciples are the perfect example. Before Pentecost, they were afraid, hiding behind locked doors. After Pentecost, they came out boldly preaching the Gospel and baptizing thousands. What changed? They were filled with the Holy Spirit.

What about us? At Baptism and Confirmation, we also received the Holy Spirit. So why do we sometimes lack joy and enthusiasm in our faith? Many people complain that Mass is boring or lifeless. But perhaps the problem is not the Mass — perhaps the problem is that our hearts have grown cold. As Fulton J. Sheen once said, “Communism has zeal without truth, while Catholics have truth without zeal.” Sometimes we act more like God’s frozen people than God’s chosen people — frozen in prayer, frozen in charity, frozen in the way we celebrate our faith. We rush through worship instead of rejoicing in God’s presence.

Pentecost reminds us to pray for a new fire in our hearts. The Holy Spirit gives us strength when we feel weak, direction when we feel lost, and courage when we face challenges. When we open our hearts to the Spirit, God renews and refreshes us.

So today let us pray with confidence:

“Lord, send out Your Spirit, and renew the face of the earth.”

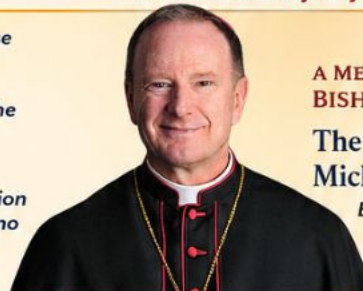

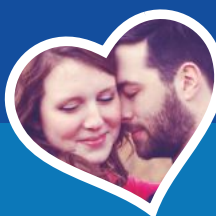
