



First Quarter 2026 Parish Financial Update

May 31, 2026

Dear Parishioners,

As we conclude the first quarter of 2026, we are grateful to share this financial update on the continued stewardship and fiscal health of St. Joseph Catholic Church, Mission San José, Diocesan Shrine of St. Joseph.

Through March 31, 2026, our parish remains in a positive financial position with a year-to-date operating budget surplus of **\$6,965**, reflecting careful financial oversight, responsible expense management, and the generosity of our parish community. While the month of March reflected a modest net loss of **\$1,211**, this was primarily due to several one-time maintenance expenses for a plumbing repair at Saint Joseph's Workshop, replacing damaged roof tiles, and fixing a roof leak at Saint Joseph Church.

Year-to-date Liturgy expenses were higher than budgeted because the invoice for the parish's gold Gospel covers was paid in the first quarter while the donations covering their purchase were received in 2025. Pre-purchased supplies for the Saint Joseph Conference also contributed to this expense category being higher than budgeted at the end of March

First quarter income was strengthened by many meaningful sources beyond regular offertory giving, including St. Joseph Conference support, mosaic donations, brick sales, Confirmation retreat revenue, and other special purpose gifts. These generous contributions are blessings that enable our parish to accomplish projects and activities that are not part of the regular parish operating budget.

While March offertory collections were slightly below budget, our parish recently began its annual increased offertory stewardship program and we are deeply grateful for the many parishioners who have already prayerfully responded. This important yearly initiative has historically helped strengthen the financial foundation of St. Joseph Parish through sustained growth in regular offertory giving, and we are encouraged by the early participation already underway. Your continued support for this effort plays a vital role in supporting our worship, ministries, operations, and the long-term financial stability of our parish community.

Overall, the first quarter reflects a parish that remains financially stable, mission-focused, and strengthened by a faithful and generous community. Although the first quarter included several substantial one-time expenses, our year-to-date position remains positive, and our parish continues to move forward through prudent planning and responsible stewardship.

Thank you for your continued prayers and financial commitment to St. Joseph Parish. Your generosity sustains our liturgies, ministries, faith formation, charitable outreach, campus preservation, and the many works entrusted to our parish family. Together, through God's grace and your faithful stewardship, we continue to strengthen the mission of St. Joseph Parish for both today and the future.
