SOLEMNITY OF CORPUS CHRISTI



Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

What makes our Catholic faith truly unique is not primarily our teachings on Mary or the Church's infallibility, but our belief in the Real Presence of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist. Because

of this doctrine, many people have left the Church because they could not accept it. Yet many others have become Catholic because they discovered it. Converts such as G.K. Chesterton, Blessed John Henry Newman, and Scott Hahn were drawn to the Catholic faith because they found Christ truly present in the Eucharist. I know it is difficult to believe that bread and wine become the Body and Blood of Christ at the consecration. It is even harder because our senses still perceive bread and wine. Yet not everything that is real can be seen. As St. Paul reminds us, "We walk by faith, not by sight." Faith allows us to see what our eyes cannot.

Today's Feast of Corpus Christi invites us to reflect on the Mass we attend each week. Why do we come to Mass? Many people, especially the young, say, "Mass is long and boring. I don't get anything out of it." My response is simple: If Mass seems long, perhaps our love is short. If Mass seems boring, perhaps we have missed its purpose. The center of the Mass is worship, and the heart of worship is sacrifice. Worship is not primarily about what we receive; it is about what we offer to God. When the bread and wine are brought to the altar, we place ourselves there as well and pray, "Lord, receive me too." The goal of Mass is not to get something out of it, but to offer God the best of who we are.

You may still say, "Father, I feel bored at Mass." That is okay. What feels boring to us is never boring to God. We do not worship an experience; we worship a Reality. If we only come when we feel inspired, then we risk worshipping our feelings instead of worshipping God. The Mass is the greatest act of worship ever given to humanity. In every Mass, we offer the sacrifice of the Son to the Father and unite our own lives to that perfect offering. We give ourselves to God without expecting anything in return. That is the proper disposition for worship.

To participate well at Mass:

1. Arrive on time.
2. Be attentive and participate actively.
3. Receive Holy Communion in the state of grace.
4. Maintain reverence and silence in church.
5. Stay for the entire Mass.

One reason many people find Mass uninteresting is that they come unprepared. Before seeing a movie, we often read reviews and learn about the story. Why not prepare for Mass in the same way? Read the Sunday readings beforehand. After Mass, discuss the readings or the homily with your family and reflect on how God may be speaking to you.

Remember: the heart of every religion is worship, and the heart of worship is sacrifice. So come to Mass with faith and joy. For at Holy Communion, we do not receive something—we receive Someone: Jesus Christ, the Bread of Life and the source of our salvation. Amen.

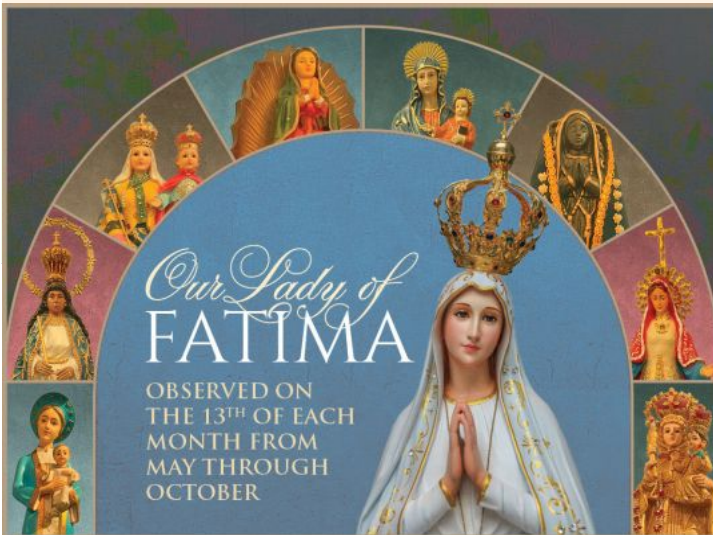

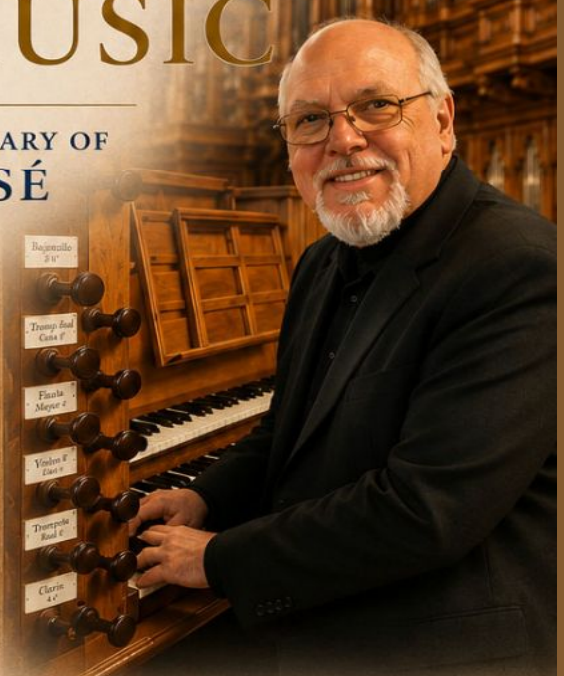

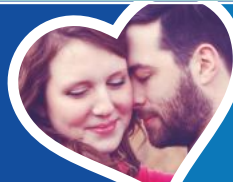
