## CELEBRATING THE 229TH ANNIVERSARY OF MISSION SAN JOSÉ



*Dear Brothers and Sisters,*

Today's readings reveal a God who chooses, loves, and sends His people on a mission. As we celebrate the 229th anniversary of our parish, these readings take on a special significance for our family of St. Joseph.

In the First Reading (Exodus 19:2-6a), God reminds the Israelites how He delivered them from slavery in Egypt and carried them “on eagle wings” to Himself. God did not choose Israel because they were the strongest or most deserving. He chose them because He loved them. The same theme continues in the Gospel (Matthew 9:36—10:8). Jesus looks upon the crowds with compassion because they are “troubled and abandoned, like sheep without a shepherd.” He then chooses the Twelve Apostles and sends them out to proclaim the Kingdom of God, heal the sick, and bring hope to the lost. Just as God chose Israel in the Old Testament, Jesus now chooses His disciples to continue His saving mission. Their mission is not based on their talents or achievements but on God's call and grace. The Second Reading (Romans 5:6-11) reminds us why this mission matters. St. Paul tells us that “while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.” The Church exists because God first loved us. Every missionary effort, every parish ministry, every act of evangelization begins with the realization that we have been loved. As the Apostles were chosen to proclaim the Gospel. We, too, through Baptism, have been chosen and sent.

Many Catholics think that missionary work is reserved for priests, religious, or professional missionaries. Yet every baptized Christian is called to share in Christ's mission. Parents evangelize their children. Teachers witness to truth and virtue. Employees and employers bring Christian values into the workplace. Students become witnesses to

faith among their friends. Wherever God has placed us, He has also given us a mission.

This same pattern is reflected in the history of our parish. Founded on June 11, 1797 by the Franciscan missionaries, this Mission was established to bring the Gospel to the people of this region. The missionaries left behind the comfort of their homes and traveled great distances because they believed that the harvest was abundant and that Christ's love was meant for all people. Their sacrifices, faith, and perseverance planted the seeds of Catholic faith that continue to bear fruit today. As we celebrate 229 years of Mission San José, we give thanks not only for the beautiful buildings and rich history that have been preserved, but also for the generations of faithful Catholics who handed on the faith. We stand on the shoulders of those who came before us—missionaries, priests, religious sisters, and parishioners whose sacrifices helped build this community.

Yet anniversaries are not only about remembering the past. They are also about renewing our commitment to the future. The mission of Mission San José is not finished. Just as God called Israel and Jesus sent the Apostles, He now sends us. The people around us still hunger for hope, truth, mercy, and the love of Christ. The harvest remains abundant. As we celebrate this anniversary, let us ask ourselves: How am I continuing the mission entrusted to this parish 229 years ago? How am I sharing the faith with my family, friends, and community?

May this anniversary renew our gratitude for God's blessings and inspire us to carry forward the mission begun here in 1797. Strengthened by the Eucharist and confident in God's love, may we continue to be faithful disciples and joyful missionaries for generations to come. Amen!
