IF GOD IS NOT FIRST, EVENTUALLY EVERYTHING ELSE BECOMES DISORDERED.



*Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ, The Gospel of this 13th Sunday Year A is one of the most challenging passages Jesus ever spoke. "Whoever loves father or mother more than me is not worthy of me." At first,*

these words sound harsh. Jesus is not telling us to stop loving our families. After all, He Himself taught us to honor our father and mother. What Jesus is saying is this: If God is not first, eventually everything else becomes disordered. When God is first, we love our family better. When God is first, we become better spouses, parents, children, priests, and friends. Think of the sun in our solar system. Every planet stays in its proper orbit because the sun is at the center. Remove the sun, and everything flies into chaos.

The same is true in our spiritual lives. In the first reading, a wealthy woman welcomed the prophet Elisha into her home. She was not seeking recognition or reward. She simply recognized God's presence in the prophet and offered generous hospitality. Because she put God first, God blessed her beyond her expectations with the gift of a son. *Her story reminds us that whenever we make room for God, God makes room for blessings in our lives.*

Jesus goes even further: "Whoever does not take up his cross and follow after me is not worthy of me." Notice He does not say, "Whoever takes up his pillow." He says, "Take up your cross." Every disciple carries a cross: illness, family struggles, financial worries, disappointments, loneliness, misunderstandings.

*The question is not whether we have a cross. The question is: Will we carry it with Jesus or without Him?* Then Jesus gives us one of the great paradoxes of the Gospel: "Whoever finds his life will lose it, and whoever loses his life for my sake will find it." The world says: "Take care of yourself first." "Look out for number one." "Life is about getting." Jesus says: "Life is about giving." A candle loses itself by burning, but only then does it give light. A seed falls into the ground and dies, but only then does it bear fruit. Christ gave His life on the Cross, and through that sacrifice He brought salvation to the world.

There is a story about a missionary doctor who spent his life caring for lepers. Someone once asked him, "Would you do this work for a million dollars?" He replied, "Not for a million dollars." The person was shocked. "Then why do you do it?" The doctor answered: "For Jesus Christ." That is the secret of Christian discipleship. When we do things merely for ourselves, we grow tired. When we do them for Christ, we discover joy.

*Today Jesus asks each of us: Who comes first in your life? If Christ is first, everything else will eventually find its proper place. May we have the courage to put Him above every attachment, carry our crosses faithfully, and serve others generously. And remember: if Jesus is not Lord of all, He is not Lord at all. But when He is first in our lives, we lose nothing and gain everything.*
